Dear Exhibitor:

Thank you for selecting the Washington, DC, PRIDE Day Festival to showcase your products and services. Your *Exhibitor Set-Up Schedule* is attached, along with *General Information* you may find helpful.

Added features will create a more colorful and professional Festival:

- All of the exhibitor booths will be 10'X10', with an awning covering the top. These awnings will be in repeating stripes of the rainbow flag. (see attached diagram)
- One table and two chairs are provided with each booth. Additional tables may be rented on site--or bring your own.
- Your display will be easy to locate, because each exhibitor will be provided a professionally lettered identification sign measuring 7"X44" with company/organization name, city/state, and booth number. The sign will be placed top, center on your booth.

If you prefer using a tent structure of your own, or if you are cooking food items in your exhibit space, sections of the awning can be removed to accommodate your activities. These situations will be handled on site during installation. If you will be cooking, a portable fire extinguisher must be in a ready status in your booth. Banners or signs may be hung from the frame of the booth. Useful hint: wire shower curtain rings work well.

When you arrive on Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning to set up your booth, first go to the Exhibitor Registration tent at the main entrance. We will sign you in, provide your allotment of complementary exhibitor badges, additional personnel badges as needed on a cash basis, and if needed, a vehicle pass permitting you to briefly off-load booth supplies on the property.

Exhibitors who missed the Monday, June 7, deadline for inclusion in the *PRIDE Day Supplement* in *The Washington Blade* will be included in the master exhibitor listing distributed during the festival.

Your enthusiasm and support will make this year's PRIDE Day the best ever!
